COURSE DESCRIPTION

Students will complete an in depth study of both the structure and the function of the human body. Students will investigate how the different systems of the body work together to make a complex, functioning organism. They will learn about conditions and diseases that affect human health. Furthermore, careers in the medical field will be explored. There will be research, activities and labs, lectures and memory work.

MATERIALS

Each student is required to have a **3-ring binder**. There will be many handouts that students will refer to often and will need to keep organized. Students need to have their own **paper, pens/pencils, colored pencils, and text book** everyday.

ATTENDANCE POLICY AMENDMENT:

Please refer to your student hand book for the **RHS Attendance Policy**. Students absent from class more than 5 days must make up all work and time in order to receive credit for the course. **STUDENTS WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO MAKE UP 5 ABSENCES PER BLOCK PER SEMESTER, so more than 10 absences means no credit! This policy will be strictly enforced.** Students are responsible for seeing me to collect their missed assignments. Students may schedule a time either before or after school to complete any missed tests, labs, or quizzes. Class time will not be used for making up assignments.
****Note** 3 tardies to class will result in one absence. If students arrive to class without a note after being absent, they must go to the office to get one and will be counted tardy.**

GRADING POLICY

Tests and special projects will comprise 50%, labs and quizzes comprise 35%, and homework and class work comprise 15% of the total grade each nine week period. At any time you may be quizzed on assigned readings or homework. A cumulative final exam is required for any student who is absent more that two (2) days. This includes any absence from class due to tardies or OSS, but not field trips. The final exam is 25% of the semester grade.

EXPECTATIONS FOR CONDUCT

All rules pertaining to student conduct in your **Student Handbook** must be followed while in the classroom. The RHS Disciplinary Code will be strictly enforced. Please note the **CELL PHONE POLICY** and the **DRESS CODE**. Safety rules and guidelines are outlined in your **“Safety in the Science Laboratory” agreement**. These contracts should be read and signed by you and your parents.
