BULLDOG TIME EARLY RELEASE AGREEMENT

Bulldog Time policies and procedures for the spring 2012 semester have been redesigned to enhance the effectiveness of the remediation time for students. Due to this change, some of our policies and bell schedule have been changed to create a more streamline approach to interventions for students.

THS' bell schedule will change slightly beginning January 27th, 2012. Below is a copy of this change:

At 2:40 p.m., students who have not been assigned office hours, detention, or the ZAP room will be permitted to leave campus. Students who drive or are car riders will be eligible to leave at this time. Students who are assigned office hours, detention, or the ZAP room must remain on campus until 3:15p.m. regardless of their transportation situation. Students who leave at 2:40 p.m. and are supposed to be in remediation, detention or the ZAP room will be considered skipping and given a disciplinary action by the THS administrative staff.

For students to be eligible to leave campus at 2:40 p.m., the agreement below must be signed and returned to your student's homeroom teacher. Without this signed agreement your student will not be allowed to leave campus until the normal release time of 3:15p.m.
