• **Office Hours-**

- Students will now be assigned Office Hours based on academic requirements only.
- If a student is making a 76 or below in any class, they ***must*** be assigned Office Hours for that class.
- If a student desires extra help in a class, they can come on their own without being assigned by a teacher.
- Office Hours will run on a daily schedule that coincides with our class schedule.
  - First block teachers will assign first block students on Monday's only. Second block teachers on Tuesday. Third block teachers on Wednesday. Fourth block teachers on Thursday.
    - *Students should not be assigned for Office Hours at a different time that we have designated for that particular class.*
- The first Friday of the month will be reserved for 1<sup>st</sup> block classes. The second Friday of the month will be reserved for 2<sup>nd</sup> block classes. (So on and so forth)
  - For example: January 27<sup>th</sup> will be reserved for 4<sup>th</sup> block classes.

• **Enrichment/Activities-**

- THS will continue to offer enrichment opportunities for all students during the school day including but not limited to: guest speakers, games/tournaments, intramurals, and college-board assistance.
- Any activity, pep rally, or guest speaker that requires the student body will be scheduled 1 month in advance.
  - All students, regardless of academic standing, will be required to stay until 3:15 for these events.

- **Detention-**
  - F-64 will be the room on campus designated for detention.
  - Detention can be given for excessive tardiness, classroom disruptions, or any other category 1 behavior. (*Reference: Appendix A*)
  - Detention can be assigned by the teacher and requires 24 hour notification for the student and the parent.
    - Parent notification is **REQUIRED** for the behavior that warrants detention.
  - If a student does not show up for their designated detention, they will be considered skipping class and will be written up by a THS administrator.
  
- **The ZAP Room- (Zeros Aren't Permitted)**
  - F-63 will be designated as the ZAP room.
  - Students, who do not complete homework, make a zero on a project, or need a place to make up a test; can be assigned to this room. If teachers would rather have students make up a test in their classrooms that is certainly permitted.
  - Students assigned to the ZAP room will not be released from this room until their work is complete. In other words, if a student is assigned the ZAP room and decides to come and not do any work, they must return the following day. This process will repeat until the work is completed.
  - Any student assigned to the ZAP room who does not attend, will be considered skipping class and will be written up by a THS administrator.
  
- **How to sign a student up for Office Hours, Detention, or the ZAP Room-**
  - Every teacher must email Mr. Brown the students assigned to the ZAP room and/or detention.
    - Students who are not on the list for Detention or ZAP will not be permitted in the room so it is imperative that teachers send the names via email to Mr. Brown.
  - Since we are using our class schedule for Office Hours, you will not need to send a copy of who is in your office hours from day to day. We will not be using GOOGLE DOCS from this point on.
    - You ARE required to have students coming in for remediation and/or extra help sign in.
    - A copy of your weekly sign in sheets are to be turned into Mr. Brown's box every Friday.
  
- **Professional Learning Communities-**
  - Due to the new schedule of Bulldog Time (assigning office hours by period) and the fact that teachers do not have a common planning period, no PLC's will be offered during Bulldog Time.

- Teachers will be required to meet once a month either before school or after school to complete their PLC's.
- **Duty Roster**
  - *Teachers are assigned duty based on their planning period. It is imperative that all teachers be at their appropriate duty at the beginning of Bulldog Time. Some teachers have been asked to do a duty on Friday or possibly to do an extra duty. This was a requirement to ensure that all duties were covered and we thank those teachers and staff members for their extra time.*

- **Club Schedule-**
  - Due to the schedule of Office Hours, all clubs will need to use Friday as there meeting time. If a club can't meet on Friday, they are asked to meet before or after school.
- **Other designated areas-**
  - All students who are on campus during Bulldog Time but aren't signed up for Office Hours, Detention, a part of an intramural game or tournament, or the Dog Pound must be in the cafeteria.
    - All students in the cafeteria must be in a seat. No student will be allowed to enter or exit the cafeteria after the 2:45 bell or before the 3:15 bell.
  - Any student on campus who is participating in an intramural activity must be in the gym for that game. No spectators will be allowed in the gym for the games. All tournament championships will be played during pep rallies for the student body.
