

Trinity High School Parent-Teacher-Student Organization
Minutes
March 14, 2011

The March 14, 2011 meeting of the Trinity High School Parent Teacher Student Organization was called to order at 6:07pm.

Minutes: Ms. Altizer reviewed the minutes from the February 21, 2011 meeting. Dawn Seltzer moved that the minutes be approved. Kathy Weeks seconded the motion. The minutes were unanimously approved.

Principal's Report (attached):

Additional items:

EOC Scores for fall term—These are not disaggregated by the type of class i.e. Honors, Standard etc. While Biology's scores are low, they have shown growth; faculty and administration continue to work to improve these scores. Aside from RECHS, Trinity will probably have the top score on the Civics exam. This used to be a low scoring exam for Trinity but Mr. Rogers and Ms. Routh have really turned the scores around. Students also received high scores on the Algebra II exam.

Archdale-Trinity Tax Council—There are three parents with associations to Trinity running for Archdale-Trinity Tax Council. PTSO needs to encourage eligible voters to attend the Tax Council meeting on Wednesday March 16 at the Trinity theatre to vote.

Registration—Students are getting signatures this week for approvals.

Board of Education Meeting—Wrestlers who went to the state meet and won will be honored.

Reality Fair—This is a program that is done in all high schools by Communities in Schools. It is a simulation exercise centered on consumer education for at risk students.

College Night—This is for anyone but especially for juniors and seniors.

Band Booster Fundraiser—The gates will open at 1pm. PTPB performs from 3-6. The event will be held in the stadium—if it rains, in the gym.

VIP Program—Guil-Rand Fire Department offers this program, which is about teenagers, killed in accidents especially those that involved drugs or alcohol.

Jake Carroll Memorial—The area where there are some torn up benches might be a good location for the memorial because it as a part that is sheltered as well as a part that is not. Ms. Parry mentioned that security cameras would be necessary to monitor the memorial to protect it from vandalism and theft. Mr. Altizer reiterated this mentioning the recent theft of bronze cemetery urns in High Point.

Ms. Lackey excused herself to attend the soccer game.

Treasurer's Report (attached): Ms. Weeks presented the report. No questions were asked.

President's Report:

Jake Carroll Memorial fundraisers (report attached)—\$1150 has been collected thus far which is as much as the original quote to install the memorial with a granite or marble pedestal. Ms. Parry

passed a picture and the text for the proposed pedestal and statue arrangement. Ms. Spencer received a donation of \$250 as well from a couple at church who are very interested in their donation going to the fund. Additionally, Brandon Parry's employer may make a donation as well. One article was submitted to the Archdale-Trinity News for anyone who would like to have a marker for a family member who is a deceased veteran and alumnus of Trinity High School. Another article will be submitted prior to the ceremony to dedicate the memorial. The statue itself is bronze and will be welded to the pedestal. Ms. Parry will be contacting >>> to get a date and time setup to have the memorial installed. Ms. Spencer requested that donated funds be kept specifically for the Memorial Fund because the donors prefer that. There will probably be other costs such as landscaping associated with the memorial for which these will be needed.

Penny Jar Fundraiser—Ms. Parry was not able to get affordable bottles for the penny fundraiser so she purchased 10 large buckets and is decorating them for each department. Some of the departments are Exceptional children, Fine Arts, Mathematics, Science, Business, English, G Building et cetera. She asked about how many teachers there were per department and the consensus was that each department could share among their members. This fundraiser supports the general operating fund of the PTSO. The logistics of the reward (pizza party/ice cream or something similar) will be worked out between now and the end of the fundraiser.

Senior Tiles—Ms. Parry sold tiles at lunch hour last week and only one more tile was purchased. Lowes Hardware will donate supplies if students are learning a trade so she is going to contact Mr. Dorsett to see if his first period class can do the tile installation during their class period instead of on a Saturday. Members felt this was an excellent idea.

VIP Program—The PTSO costs for this program will be approximately \$100 which will provide lunch for 30 people.

Miss Trinity Pageant payout (report attached)--The listed students will have to document with a college acceptance letter and student number that they have enrolled at a college next year. The funds will then be mailed to the college or university. The theatre teacher, Mr. Johnson, may be interested in running the pageant next year.

Old Business:

Landscaping at curve behind Math Building—Ms. Seltzer asked for donations from clubs of one tree and received 11. An earth science class has donated a tree for a class project. She may need to purchase mulch. Perhaps Lowe's Hardware could donate the mulch as long as students are involved and learning something educational i.e. landscaping.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:42. The next meeting will be held April 11th, 2011.
