Minutes
December 13, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Becky Spencer who was presiding in the absence of Natalie Parry.

Principal's Report: Ms. Zomberg read the principal's report in the absence of Ms. Denise Lackey. The report is attached. Additional comments to the report include the following: The Christmas concert will involve a spaghetti dinner. The various tournaments around Christmas are for basketball.

Memorial: Ms. Spencer reported on the purchase and placement of the Fallen Soldier Memorial statue in memory of Jake Carroll. The statue has been purchased for \$260.82 by the PTSO and is in the office. A pedestal will be purchased which has a value of \$3,000. The company will sell it to the high school for \$1,000. A fundraiser to sell replica pins of the statue is on sale for \$4. One order of 150 pins has been almost completely sold and more are on order. Wayne Industries has donated \$100. A letter has been sent to faculty mailboxes and additional efforts to get the word out will continue. There will be more opportunities to push this effort after the Christmas break.

Budget Report: Ms. Spencer read the budget report which was submitted by Ms. Natalie Parry. The ending balance on December 6th was 3,436.66. Disbursements include the following: Miss Trinity to Christina Roach and Hannah Flippin \$200 and \$300, respectively; memorial statue \$260.82. Additional income received but not deposited includes pin income \$254, donations for Jake Carroll \$115, PTSO Dues \$10.

Miss Trinity Pageant questions: Questions were raised about the Miss Trinity pageant and the pageant and current status were explained to new attendees. The deadline for payment is December 16th and to date no sponsorship monies have been turned in. The sponsorship requirement is \$100. There has to be a minimum of 10 sponsored girls for the pageant to proceed. There will be no scholarships for the pageant this year.

Trinity Fitness: Ms. Rachel Jackson will have a classroom set up for Trinity Fitness after Christmas. She has submitted a grant to fund Wiis for the classroom.

Cleanup Day: Ms. Dawn Seltzer is waiting until the spring to hold a cleanup day. She is hoping to get donations and assistance to construct a new sign beyond the math building.

Fundraisers: Ms. Parry has lined up toboggans that say Bulldogs and THS to sell at basketball games. Kathy Weeks was able to arrange purchasing them for 75 cents each and Ms Parry is having them embroidered. They will be sold for \$10. Also scarves and the statue replica pins will be sold.

Question from the Minutes: A question was raised about the installation of the tiles. An explanation that the time and materials are being donated and the installation will take place when weather is warmer.

College/Career Fair: Ms. Jackson will be holding a college and career fair during 4th block. She is having returning graduates and business leaders to be available and provide information and answer questions for seniors.

Jeans or Hats Fundraisers: All teachers present felt that hats were a better fundraiser for students to pay to wear than jeans with holes because of the associated discipline issues with the jeans.

Senior Boards Night: The Exceptional Children's department put together the food for the judges. Pasta salad was provided by Archdale Friends; sandwiches were catered. Other food was provided as well.

Approval of Minutes: Ms. Saruse moved that the minutes be accepted with the change that teacher were not fed on the night of senior boards. This correction will be made. Also the time of adjournment for the November 8th meeting will be changed from 8:17 to 7:17pm. Mr. Shelton seconded the motion. All present voted to approve the minutes with those corrections.

The meeting adjourned at 6:31pm. The next meeting will be held January 10, 2011.
